Operation details:

Standard right hemiarthroplasty done by posterior approach.

Curved posterior incision made towards PSIS and fascia lata was exposed. Fascial plane was developed with Cobb and dry lap. Glut medius and minimus were retracted anteriorly and glut max was split with blunt dissection. SERs were dissected and GT exposed identifying and preserving sciatic nerve. Bone canal was prepared and bone cement was inserted. Head and neck size was trialled and fixed with +8 size.

Haemostasis was achieved and acetabulum was irrigated. Short external rotators and capsular layer sutured with #5 Ethibond figure of 8 sutures.

3-0 vicryl for subcutaneous tissue and use 3-0 nylon for skin.
