Re: Mr Stephen Cotter

Thank you for agreeing to see Mr Cotter. He is a 64-year-old retired police officer who presented with a 3-month history of vocal hoarseness. He also complains of odynophagia, dysphagia with solids and right-sided otalgia.

Mr Cotter has an 80 pack year smoking history, and drinks approx. 4 standard drinks on week nights, and 8 standard drinks on a Friday or Saturday night.

On examination, Mr Cotter has a gravelly voice which was notably different than his previous visit with me. He has a palpable, painless anterior cervical lymph node.

Mr Cotter has a longstanding history of well-controlled GORD, he currently takes 40mg pantoprazole OD. He has no other chronic health issues and no significant family history.
