CLINICAL NOTES:

Staging CT for likely glottic squamous cell carcinoma.

DIAGNOSIS:

There is a glottic carcinoma arising from the right cord present as per the clinical history. There is thickening of the anterior commissure and spread to contralateral cord with subglottic extension.

There is necrotic right level III node.

No obvious distal metastatic disease is identified.
