Thank you for accepting to seeing Mrs Hansen. She is a 67-year-old retired primary school teacher who presented with a palpable mass in her left breast. I arranged a mammogram which showed a single dominant lesion measuring 2x2cm with irregular borders and microcalcifications. She had her previous mammogram 18 months ago with no abnormalities.

She is currently not taking any regular medications or has any relevant personal medical history. Mrs Hansen's mother was previously diagnosed with breast cancer at age 50.
