### History of Present Illness

Mr Hendricks is a 55-year-old gentleman who presented for an elective/semi-urgent right renal biopsy. This is on a background of abdominal pain and weight loss over 4 months and frank haematuria for the previous 2 weeks. CT imaging revealed renal mass and CXR indicated lung metastases. Renal biopsy results were of renal cell carcinoma- clear cell type, grade 3. He has been referred to JHH.
