Re: Mr Kyle Hughes

Thank you for accepting to seeing Mr Hughes. He is a 68-year-old retired butcher who is known to have worsening ischaemic heart disease despite appropriate medical management. Percutaneous coronary intervention was attempted in April 2018 with failed stenting.

Currently Mr Hughes is complaining of intermittent central chest discomfort which is occurring if he walks for more than five minutes or climbs one flight of stairs. This intermittent chest pain resolves either with rest or the use of his GTN spray.

I would like to refer him on to you for further investigation and a possible coronary artery bypass graft as all other options are currently not managing his ischaemic heart disease.
