Dear Doctor,

Re: Miss Bridie Nolan

Thank you for agreeing to see Miss Nolan in the ENT outpatient clinic. She is a 24yo female with recurrent otitis media. I have referred her to your service two months prior at which point she was placed on the waiting list. However since then she has developed a chronic discharge from her left ear and some associated hearing loss.

Miss Nolan is a PE teacher, she is also an avid surfer and in training for an iron woman competition at the end of this year. Her recurrent ear infections and hearing loss are interfering with her work and competitive activities. I wish to request that Miss Nolan be moved up on the waiting list for an earlier appointment with the clinic.

Socially, Miss Nolan has social alcohol use and is a non-smoker.

On otoscopy there is a profuse yellow watery discharge from the left ear making examination of the tympanic membrane difficult. Right tympanic membrane is normal. Some palpable post auricular lymph nodes on the left were noted.

Miss Nolan has no chronic health concerns. Her only medication is the OCP.

Thank you for the consideration of moving this patient up the waiting list. I believe she would benefit from a more expedited ENT review.
