Re: Mrs Rebecca Pierce

Thank you for accepting to see above patient. She is a 47-year-old radiographer who presented with a progressively enlarging goitre for 1 year with no features of tracheal /SVC compression, no change in voice. She C/O symptoms of mild thyrotoxicosis during the last 3 months, sweating, palpitations, anxiety, losing weight despite increased appetite, but with Rx the symptoms had been reduced.

Ultrasound reports confirmed two nodules on both lobes of the gland and Fine Needle Aspiration Cytology (FNAC) of the dominant R/s nodule with a possible follicular lesion.

She is on:

- Carbimazole (Neo-Mercazole) 5mg BID
- Atenelol 25mg BID

I am referring Mrs Peirce to you for further management.
