Dear Doctor,

Re: Mr Arthur Ryan

Thank you for accepting to seeing Mr Ryan. He is a 64-year-old chef in Singleton who presented with intermittent left leg claudication and left leg rest pain while in bed. I arranged an ankle brachial index which was 0.5 and a toe brachial index which was 0.25 on the left leg. Right leg was within the normal ranges.

He is currently using Candesartan 16mg and hydrochlorothiazide 12.5mg for hypertension, Atorvastatin 40mg for dyslipidaemia and esomeprazole 40mg for GORD. He is allergic to perindopril. He also has a 50 pack year smoking history.

I would like to refer him onto you for further investigation and management.
