CLINICAL NOTES:

Non-contrast head CT for evaluation of intracranial haemorrhage following MVA.

DIAGNOSIS:

Moderate left epidural haematoma measuring 18mm in maximal depth. Associated with an undisplaced left temporoparietal skull fracture.

There are thin bilateral subdural haematomas overlying left and right temporal lobes. There is blood layered on the tentorium cerebelli and an intraparenchymal haemorrhage involving the left middle/superior temporal gyrus. Likely representing coup and contrecoup injuries.

There is mild mass effect. No hydrocephalus. There is also a fracture through the anterior maxillary wall and floor of left orbit.

No cervical spine injuries noted.
