CLINICAL NOTES:

RUQ pain with likely biliary cholic and jaundice. ?Cholecystitis ?choledocholithiasis.

DIAGNOSIS:

The gall bladder contains sludge and small stones measuring up to about 4mm. Evidence of cholecystitis with gall bladder wall measuring 4mm and pericholecystic fluid.

There is biliary tree dilatation, CBD measuring 7mm.

The liver appears normal apart from some notable dilated intrahepatic biliary tree. No focal lesions noted.

The kidneys appear normal and there is no ascites.

CONCLUSION:

There is cholelithiasis with evidence of cholecystitis and likely choledocholithiasis.
