DOB: 22/03/1970

Mrs Watson had a laparoscopic cholecystectomy on 22 May 2018 due to cholecystitis with choledocholithiasis. The intraoperative cholangiogram showed non-uniform passage of contrast through the CBD with a filling defect noted. We have a high suspicion there is an impacted stone in the CBD that will likely require retrieval.

To further complicate matters, Mrs Watson had a bile leak with biliary peritonitis requiring an emergency laparotomy, bile duct repair and washout on 24 May 2018.

Background: Asthma and depression

Medications:

- Seretide Accuhaler 250/50mcg 1 puff INH BD
- Salbutamol MDI 100mcg 1-2 puffs INH PRN
- Sertraline 100mg PO mane

Please consider seeing Mrs Watson for consideration of an ERCP.
