CLINICAL NOTES:

Worsening abdominal pain. Likely pancreatitis. ?extent of disease. ?other possible pathology.

DIAGNOSIS:

Pancreas appears to be heterogenous in character with surrounding peripancreatic fat stranding. This is consistent with an acute pancreatitis. No calcifications suggestive of chronic disease. There also appears to be cholelithiasis with choledocholithiasis at the greater duodenal papilla. Gall bladder wall does not appear to be thickened.
