CLINICAL NOTES:

Known acute pancreatitis. Worsening abdominal pain. Clinical deterioration. ?pancreatitis complications ?other pathology.

DIAGNOSIS:

Pancreas appears to be heterogenous in character and further peripancreatic fat stranding from the last imaging. There also appears to be gas bubbles within an area of pancreatic necrosis. This is indicative of infected pancreatic necrosis. Urgent management advised.
