Re: Mr Fredrick Cunningham

Thank you for accepting to seeing Mr Cunningham. He is a 76-year-old retired farmer who presented with painless PR bleeding which had been ongoing for 3 days prior to seeing me. He describes having tenesmus over the last few months and admits to some unintentional weight loss.

He is currently on perindopril 5mg PO mane and atorvastatin 40mg PO nocte for hypertension and dyslipidaemia. Mr Cunningham also believes his maternal grandfather and aunty had bowel cancer but is unsure on this.

On digital rectal examination, I was able to palpate a rough mass in the rectum and would like to refer him onto you for further investigation and management.
